

Privacy policy for the website of the spare parts catalogue of Sumitomo (SHI) Demag Plastics Machinery GmbH

We, Sumitomo (SHI) Demag Plastics Machinery GmbH and our subsidiaries, offer our customers products in the field of plastics processing, especially in the field of injection moulding machines. Security and protection of personal data is an important aspect of customer care.

The following data protection declaration describes which personal data we collect from you as a visitor to this website and for what purpose we use this personal data. In addition, we inform you how long we store your personal data and which rights you have with regard to the processing of your personal data.

§ 1 General information on the collection and use of personal data

(1) Personal information is information that identifies you (such as your name) or information that makes you identifiable (such as your mailing address, IP address, telephone number, location, profile settings).

(2) Personal data is collected and used by us to the extent necessary to provide a functional and easy-to-use website and to offer our content and services. Your personal data will always be processed on the basis of the relevant statutory provisions, about which we will inform you in more detail below.

§ 2 Responsible person and data protection officer

(1) Responsible for the data processing is according to Art. 4 No. 7 EU General Data Protection Regulation (**GDPR**):

§ 3 Your rights

(1) You have the following rights against us with regard to the personal data relating to you, which you can exercise at datenschutzbeauftragter@dpg.com and the above address:

- Right of access (Art. 15 GDPR),
- Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR),
- Right to cancellation (Art. 17 GDPR),
- Right to limitation of processing (Art. 18 GDPR),
- Right to data transferability (Art. 20 GDPR),
- Right of withdrawal (Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR),
- Right to object (**right to object**, Art. 21 GDPR).

The following applies to your **right to object**:

Insofar as we base the processing of your personal data on the legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. f) GDPR, you may object to the processing of your personal data at any time for reasons arising from your particular situation.

If you object, we will no longer process personal data relating to you unless we can prove compelling reasons worthy of protection which outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms or the processing serves the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims.

(2) Finally, you have the right to lodge a complaint with any supervisory authority, in particular in the EU Member State of your place of residence, workplace or place of presumed infringement, if you consider that the processing of the data concerning you

is contrary to the law. Further administrative or judicial remedies that you may be entitled to remain unaffected by this.

§ 4 Collection and use of personal data when visiting our website

(1) Within the scope of using the order function for spare parts on our website, we process personal data relating to your person. For registration on our website, we collect name, e-mail address, username, password. For the execution of the order process we collect name, address, company, position, telephone number, e-mail address. Insofar as the collection and processing of personal data relating to your person is necessary for the execution of the contract, the legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. b) GDPR, insofar as you yourself are our contractual partner. If you are not our contractual partner yourself, but a contact person at a company, the legal basis for the processing of your personal data is our legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. f) GDPR. In this respect, our legitimate interest lies in the execution of the purchase contract. If you provide further information in your account, this is based on your consent pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. a) GDPR.

(2) In addition to the aforementioned data processing, cookies and log files are processed when using our website. Further information can be found in § 5 of this data protection declaration. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your hard drive assigned to the browser you are using and through which the information described in § 5 of this data protection declaration flows to us. Cookies cannot execute programs or transmit viruses to your computer. They serve to make the Internet offer more user-friendly and more effective.

§ 5 Use of cookies and log files

1. Technically required cookies

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your hard drive assigned to the browser you are using. Cookies contain information that can be read by a web server in the domain in which the cookie was given to you even after your visit to our website. The

information collected through the use of cookies is used to analyse the function and use of the websites by creating evaluations and graphics on the number of visits and the number of pages accessed per user. The analyses are used exclusively for the purposes of our own market research as well as the optimisation and design of the website in line with requirements. Cookies cannot execute programs or transmit viruses to your computer.

We use session cookies technically required for our website in order to simplify the use of our website for you and to ensure during your visit to our website that, for example, saved search queries are retained during the session.

The legal basis for the use of cookies is our legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. f) GDPR. Our legitimate interest lies in offering and providing the website.

Cookies cannot be manually deactivated by you via our website. However, you have the option of setting your browser settings to refuse cookies in general. In this case not all functions of the website can be used.
